

This years Liberty Bell Classic was a huge success.

Nick finished with a 2nd place trophy. The first night took place at Katmandu in Trenton NJ where the strongmen had a Log Clean and Press for reps with 308lb. Nick completed 4 reps. Following the log was the Hummer Tire Deadlift where Nick pulled 900 lbs with ease.



The next day was held in conjunction with Welcome America in Philly. The day was started with a 10,000 lb Truck Pull. Nick finished the pull in 30.11. After the truck pull was the Yoke and Shield medley. The athletes carried a 900lb yoke 50 ft followed by a 400lb shield carry 50 ft. Nick's completed the yoke within the blink of an eye and it took him 26.58 sec on the shield carry.



The third event of the day was a tractor tire flip and Harley drag. The athletes flipped a 700lb tractor tire five times immediately followed with a 1,400 lb Harley sled drag (with two girls on it) Nick completed the tire flip and moved the sled just under 50 ft.

The last event was the Stones of Strength following a Trenton Rockets baseball game. The athletes loaded stones 250 325 340 407 and 420 onto platforms beginning at 64in

60in 56in 52in and 48in. Nick loaded four stones, and lapped the last stone securing him a solid second place overall.
